What is an Ethics Olympiad?

During the day all teams will be involved in a series of three Ethics Olympiad heats where they will be scored according to set criteria which rewards, clear, concise, respectful discourse around challenging ethical cases. At the end of the day, scores will be collated and teams will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals based on the scores. The Ethics Olympiad will provide participants with a unique and rewarding experience as they engage with other tertiary students from throughout Australasia in a format that promotes civil, critical and collaborative discourse.

How does it work?

We will use Zoom on the day. Once registered coaches and eth-letes will receive training kits and eight ethical cases. Each tertiary institution will send a team or two teams of five students (eth-letes). The heats will be run simultaneously- with a common format and common timing. Specialists will be judging each heat on the day. There will be a round robin format with each team taking turns to present and critique arguments. Please note, this is not a debate as teams can agree with each other about the best ethical outcome. All participants will receive a certificate and the winning teams will receive medals to be mailed to the coach for distribution.
